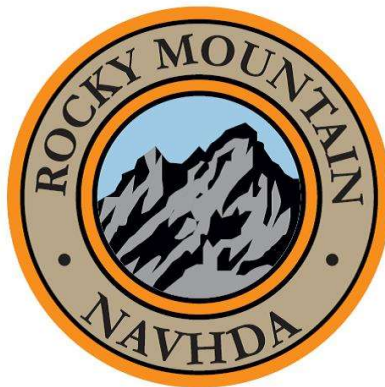


RMC NAVHDA STEADINESS CLINIC
