- 7. Old Business
 - a. No ongoing discussion carried over from last year.
- 8. New Business
 - a. Chapter Annual Dues Membership Vote
 - i. Currently \$40 for Family Chapter Membership (Board proposes it stays the same for 2023) request to review by-laws for membership due voting. By-law's state "for upcoming year." Since meeting is always held in January, this statement is assumed to be for the following year.

Board unanimously approved to keep dues at \$40 for 2023.

- b. Set 2022 Chapter Test Dates
 - i. May 13, 14, and 15
 - ii. August 19, 20, and 21
 - iii. CPW has changed to granting permits the week prior. Question for Theo on how the grounds will be guaranteed for us.

Board unanimously approves testing dates

- c. 2022 Training Day Schedule
 - i. Small game or fishing license is required by everyone coming to the Cobb Lake training days as per new CPW regulation released in 2020.
 - ii. Calendar of all training days/nights to be posted on website
 - 1. 5 training days at Cobb Lake SWA
 - 2. Continue training nights at Surefire Kennel
 - 3. Continue 2 training days at Jackson Creek Kennel
 - iii. Any youth handlers with a dog MUST have a legal guardian with them at all times.
 - iv. Change to bird pick up all birds must be picked up first thing in the morning on the training day.
 - v. Hold a NAVHDA AIMS Clinic for UT/INVT trainers. July 9, 10 (get permit for 8-11). NAVHDA international restricts this to 20 handlers.

Board unanimously approves the outlined training plan.

- d. NAVHDA International Meeting
 - i. Virtual meeting to be held on January 29, 2022
 - ii. Chapter Delegates President, Tim Griffin, and Sara Heesacker
 - iii. Discuss International motions (increase 2 ratings to 4's for invitational dogs) RMC-NAVHDA recommends "NO" on both motions.
- e. Motion presented by Sara Heesacker:
 - Transition Member at Large position to Director of Youth Development beginning 2023 (motion by Sara Heesacker). Remove Member at Large and replace with Director of Youth Development.
 - ii. Bylaws currently read:
 - Article 1V: Board of Directors (Officers and Directors) Section 1: The board of directors shall consist of 5 elected officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and an elected Member at Large) and 4 elected directors (Director of Training, Director of Judging, Director of Testing, and Director of Promotions and Fundraising). In the event that a directorship is shared between two people there will be only one board vote for that directorship.
 - iii. Proposed change:
 - The Board of Directors shall consist of 4 elected officers (President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary), and 5 elected directors (Director of Training, Director of Judging, Director of Testing, Director of Promotions and Fundraising, and Director of Youth Development). In the event that a

directorship is shared between two people there will be only one board vote for that directorship.

iv. Article IV: board of Directors (Officers and Directors)
Section 15: The position of Member at Large is herby created as an officer. A: provides support, recommendations and guidance to the Board

v. Proposed change:

Section 15: Director of Youth Development

- 1. Coordinate youth participation and adult volunteers for youth activities at chapter events
- 2. Create engaging activities and events specifically for chapter youth members
- 3. Assist the youth board members with their assigned roles
- 4. Support fundraising efforts designed to further the goals of the youth program
- 5. Promote the chapter's commitment to engaging youth in outdoor skills and versatile hunting dogs

Board unanimously approves to replacing member at large with director of youth development.

- 9. Additional new business:
 - a. Budget Committee volunteers are to be solicited by John Harris. Need volunteers.
 - i. Purpose: to assess financial threats to RMC-NAVHDA
 - b. Training outreach for Western Slope and other geographical areas. Need volunteers.
